The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering (CEE) at the University of Houston invites applications for one full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty position in the infrastructure materials engineering field. Candidates with multi-disciplinary interests are invited to apply at the Assistant or Associate Professor ranks. Candidates applying at the Associate Professor rank are expected to demonstrate nationally and internationally recognized scholarly activities with a strong record of externally funded research. The candidates must also demonstrate a commitment towards teaching at both undergraduate and graduate levels.

Applicants must have an earned Ph.D. degree in Civil, Environmental, or Materials Engineering, or in a closely related field. Successful candidates are expected to develop and maintain an internationally recognized, cross-disciplinary research program in collaboration with the current faculty in the Department, College, and University. Preference will be given to candidates with the potential to establish research collaborations in the energy or health industries.
