

Flowchart is only an aid for degree planning. Students are responsible for checking and adhering to requirements in Undergraduate Catalog. Requisite exceptions are communicated via flow chart and CIVE Elective Offerings (exceptions subject to change). When course requisites in Catalog change new requirements apply to all students.

## Footnotes:

- (1) Grades of C- or higher required in all science, math, and engr courses (for credit and for prerequisites). Requisite requirements are inherited (pre- and co-requisites for a course are preregs for all following courses).
- 2) Refer to Catalog and UH Testing Services website for info on equivalents and credit through examination, etc.
- (3) Refer to Catalog for requisites.
- (4) Must also complete CHEM 1311 or PHYS 2325 with C- or higher before taking ENGI 1331 Computing.
- (5) BIOL 1306 Biology I, BIOL 1307 Biology II, GEOL 1302 Intro Global Climate Change, GEOL 1303 Physical Geology, GEOL 1340 Earth Systems or GEOL 1347 Meteorology.
- (6) Catalog lists ENGI 1331 as prerequisite but allowing ENGI 1331 as corequisite.
- (7) Can substitute INDE 2333 Statistics for ENGR 2301 Statics in ENGI 2304 prerequisite requirements.
- (8) CHEM 1312/1112 w/lab is prerequisite, but allowing 1112 lab as corequisite. (Can substitute TCCNS CHEM 1409 Chem for Engrs Lecture + Lab for prerequisite).
- (9) BSCE requires four CIVE electives chosen with advisor approval. <u>All</u> CIVE electives have prerequisites. <u>One approved</u> 3000 or higher level course outside CIVE may be substituted for a CIVE elective. See approved substitute list at <u>cive.uh.edu/programs/undergraduate/advising</u>. Upper-level students with overall and major GPAs ≥ 3.0 may seek permission to use up to two CIVE graduate classes as electives (requires approval of instructor, Graduate and Undergraduate Directors).
- (10) Only guaranteed to be offered in spring semesters.
- (11) Only guaranteed to be offered in fall semesters.
- (12) Prerequisites for CIVE 4311 Prof Practice in Civil Engr are ENGI 2304 Tech Comm and any two CIVE 3000-level courses.
- (13) Dept. is allowing some leniency with respect to requirements in Undergraduate Catalog. <u>Every semester</u> INDE 2333, CIVE 3332, and CIVE 4311 are prerequisites. In <u>fall</u> semesters, CIVE 4363 and 4369 remain prerequisites but CIVE 4332 and 4333 can be taken concurrently. In <u>spring</u> semesters, CIVE 4332 and 4333 remain prerequisites but CIVE 4363 and 4369 can be taken concurrently.
